Dear Valued Customer,

Pacer Stacktrain has noticed a marked increase in loads that require additional securement (blocking and bracing) as a result of our random inspection process that we conduct jointly with our rail carriers. In an effort to maintain competitive shipping costs and minimize any disruptions in service, we ask our customers to be vigilant with their cargo securement. Proper loading, blocking and bracing is critical for the safe, reliable transit of goods, and is a requirement under the Rules and Procedures section of the Pacer Stacktrain Information Directory, as well as AAR and DOT rules.
