Re: Update: Terminal Change - Buffalo, NY to be Replaced with Buffalo ICTF

Dear Valued Customer,

The following information updates and supersedes Stack Facts #936 dated November 5, 2007:

The new CSX intermodal terminal that will replace service currently served by the Buffalo, NY intermodal terminal, effective Monday, November 19, 2007, will be named Buffalo ICTF.

The existing Buffalo, NY terminal located at 1252 Williams Street will stop all intermodal operations after closing on Sunday, November 18, 2007.

The new terminal will offer increased capacity, improved technology and additional service lanes. It is a result of public/private partnership efforts by the State of New York and CSX Corporation to expand transportation services into the region. CSX Intermodal will offer new service between the New York metropolitan area and the new Buffalo ICTF via its South Kearny, N.J. terminal. The new service provides a means for both domestic and international containers to reach the Buffalo and Toronto, ON markets six days per week. Buffalo ICTF will also continue to service the Chicago market.
