## **ALERT - UPRR Embargo of Seattle Origin and Destination**

Dear Valued Customer,

Heavy rains in the Pacific Northwest have caused high water and mudslides washing out approximately 20 miles of tracks between Seattle and Portland. As a result, the UPRR issued the following announcement this afternoon:

\*\*\*\*\*

Effective 3:00 PM PST the Union Pacific Railroad has issued an embargo on traffic entering the Seattle Ramp or any traffic destined to Seattle, Tacoma or Global Gateway North.

UP will continue to accept interchange traffic in the pipeline billed prior to date of AAR embargo. Shipments attempting to ingate at any UP intermodal facility for the destinations of Seattle, WA, Tacoma, WA and/or Global Gateway North, WA will be rejected. Billing will continue to be accepted with the exception of billing for shipments originating at Tacoma or Global Gateway North, WA. Shipments on-hand at Seattle can be picked up. Shipments enroute or currently gated will be operated to destination as the situation allows.
