BNSF High Value Shipments

Dear Valued Customer,

Pacer Stacktrain is pleased to provide details about shipping high valued goods on the BNSF Railway. The following processes and requirements will become effective April 4, 2008.

Pacer Stacktrain has enrolled in the BNSF's Strategic Transportation Asset Tracking (STAT) program. STAT enables you to move high value commodities under greater security. With the STAT program, the BNSF Railway Police and security guards can better identify, track and protect high-value or high-risk intermodal loads from the time they are in-gated, loaded on railcars, transported, deramped all the way to the out-gating. STAT will provide a snapshot of the exact status of these loads, including railcar initial/number, container/trailer initial/number, current city/state, train symbol, route, lading or shipper and final destination.

The qualifications of a BNSF STAT load are a minimum load value of \$250,000 or \$100,000 if it is an agreed upon at risk cargo. The following shipments qualify by the BNSF as a STAT load regardless of their value: consumer electronics, such as televisions, stereos, video or digital recorders, personal computers and/or monitors, truck or automobile tires, cigarettes, and distilled liquors. After being identified by the STAT program, the load is tracked as a high-value or high-risk shipment, thereby improving the inspection process of these shipments during their transportation cycle on the BNSF Railway.

Please contact your Pacer Stacktrain Business Development Representative to learn how to designate your shipments as high-value or high-risk prior to commencing service. This will assure that the STAT program works properly for your loads.
