New BNSF Intermodal Rules and Policies Guide Effective July 1, 2008

Dear Valued Customer:

BNSF Railway has announced the publication of a revised Intermodal Rules and Policies Guide (R&PG), which became effective as of July 1, 2008. The BNSF states that the R&PG has been improved by reorganizing information to help customers find the most important items, significantly shortening sections, placing charges into logical groupings, and producing an online-only version.

Please note that BNSF has made the following changes, among others, to its liability for cargo loss or damage:

- The maximum liability for cargo loss or damage reduced from \$250K to \$200K
- The minimum claim amount for cargo loss or damage increased from \$250 to \$500
