

Announcing BNSF Service between the Pacific Northwest and the Southeast (and Puerto Rico), Effective October 6, 2008

Dear Valued Customer,

In an effort to better serve you, Pacer Stacktrain is continuing to add new Service origins and destinations on the BNSF rail network. We are pleased to announce that effective October 6, 2008, we will be offering service between between the Pacific Northwest (Seattle and Portland) and the Southeast (Atlanta, Charlotte and Jacksonville). This COFC service is for 53' 110" and 53' 107" equipment only (48' equipment will not be supported). Should 48' equipment be utilized, the customer will be responsible for covering additional charges such as: additional drayage, transloading into 53' equipment prior to shipment, etc.
