Policy Revision Announcement

Dear Valued Customer:

In an effort to accommodate for the immediate need of 20ft and 40ft chassis in Chicago, Pacer Stacktrain has had to make a revision in the policy of decking international containers at the UPRR satellite yard known as Wolcott.

Any unit that has accrued more than 5 days of dwell time will be put to the ground effective January 9. Pacer will absorb the cost of the lift back on the chassis during this time.

Lift hours are from 0800-1630 M-F.

Customers will receive a notice that their unit will be grounded once the box has been at Wolcott for 5 days. Storage provisions with the railroad remain in effect. Please continue to use your chassis lift ticket form for advance reservations.

Please communicate this change with your personnel, your customers and drayage carriers. This policy will be in effect until further notice.
