CSX MAJOR TRACK WORK PROJECT EFFECTING WEST COAST TO BALTIMORE AND PORTSMOUTH SERVICE

To our valued Stacktrain customers:

In an effort to improve overall service and to insure continued long-term improvement in the quality of our service, the CSX will be implementing a major track work project to install 31,961 ties on its route between Chicago to Baltimore and Portsmouth. This major track work curfew will be in effect starting March 5, 2001 until March 29, 2001.

Because of this curfew, Pacer Stacktrain services operating between the West Coast to Baltimore and Portsmouth may be delayed. Please expect between 12 to 24 hour delay in availability to the above-mentioned origins and destinations as a result of this major track work project.
