NEW McCOOK FACILITY FOR PACER STACKTRAIN AND UPRR

To Our Valued Customers:

Pacer Stacktrain has relocated our container yard from the current Wolcott yard in Chicago, IL to the newly designed Cub Terminal in McCook, IL.

This announcement is to advise you that **effective April 9, 2001**, all international container loads will be drayed to the new McCook facility. The Union Pacific Railroad will be vacating the Wolcott yard.

The UPRR will provide normal notification of availability at McCook within 24 hours of availability at Global 1. The free time on the container is the standard UPRR arrangement.

At the end of 7 days after arrival at McCook, any unit not picked up will be grounded and the cargo will be charged for the lift back on the chassis prior to release.

The lift hours are Mon-Fri 0700-1700 and the fax number for the flip authorization is 708-485-8086.

The new facility will be lighted, has covered ingate and outgate areas, and will be paved in early spring.

The terminal is located just 11 miles southwest of the UPRR Global One ramp, with easy access off the I-55 Expressway and 1st Avenue North.

Directions from the East:

Take I-55 south to 1st Avenue (North) exit. Follow to Joliet Road exit. At stop light turn left and follow to the Cub terminal that is approximately 3 blocks on the right hand side of the street. Turn right onto the street and follow into the terminal entrance.
