TO ALL PACER STACKTRAIN CUSTOMERS

The following is an announcement from CSX Railroad:

CSXI is implementing a "bolt seal" program at all ramps. The Chicago terminals started the program this week. This program is a replica of what has been standard operating practice at the BNSF and UP for several years. Upon bringing a load to the ramp each draymen is provided a three-inch bolt and nut, which is inserted into the hasp of the trailer door.

The driver is given a tool to bend the bolt providing a simple security seal that prevents opening the door without using a bolt cutter to remove. At destination, the driver can remove the bolt at our terminal or take the load to destination for removal.

THE ONE EXCEPTION TO THIS PROGRAM WILL BE CHICAGO WHERE THE CSX SECURITY FIRM WILL APPLY THE BOLTS.

The intent and purpose of the program is to protect the customer's lading while in transit.
