Labor Day Holiday Plan

To Our Valued Stacktrain Customers:

Due to the Labor Day holiday, most Pacer Stacktrain services with a scheduled cut-off date of Monday, September 3, 2001 will not operate. There will be limited train service from major intermodal facilities on Labor Day.

Pacer Stacktrain services operating with volume tendered to the network prior to the Labor Day holiday will continue to operate through to destination, depending upon the rail carriers' crew availability. Union Pacific and CSX will attempt to shut down their rail network so that all crew members may observe the holidays with their families.

Those services with scheduled arrival and availabilities on the Labor Day holiday will be delayed a minimum of 24 hours due to the holiday operating schedule.

Union Pacific and CSX have published specific terminal operating hours for the holiday, however, most rail terminals supporting the Pacer Stacktrain network will be closed, including Kearny.

Exceptions:

The international eastbound volume from Global Gateway North and Global Gateway South will operate as normal, pending vessel arrivals.

Chicago GL01 will operate as normal depending upon gate activities.
