Peak Season Surcharge Announcement

Peak Season Surcharge Effective 8-1-2002

Effective Thursday August 1, 2002, Pacer Stacktrain will implement a peak season surcharge on all eastbound domestic shipments with origin ramps in the states of California, Oregon and Washington as outlined below. This charge will show as a separate line item on our invoice.

From origin ramps in Southern California (LAX, SAN, CDY)

• \$150 to the following destination ramps: ATL, BAL, BOS, BUF, CHS, CHR, CLE, CMH, DTT, GRS, HAR, JAX, KEA, MIA, MON, PHL, PTT, PTS, STP, SAV, SPF, SYR, TOR, WOR

\$100 to the following destination ramps: CHI, KCK, MEM, NWO, STL

• \$60 to the following destination ramps: DAL, HOU

From origin ramps in Northern California, Oregon and Washington

(OAK, SAC, SCK, POR, SEA)

• \$70 to the following destination ramps: ATL, BAL, BOS, BUF, CHS, CHR, CLE, CMH, DAL, DTT, GRS, HAR, HOU, JAX, KEA, MIA, MON, PHL, PTT, PTS, STP, SAV, SPF, SYR, TOR, WOR

• \$50 to the following destination ramps: CHI, KCK, MEM, STL

This peak season surcharge will be followed by a permanent rate increase. Notification of the permanent increase will be forwarded at the appropriate time with specific rate actions and dates that will be determined by prevailing market conditions.
