

February 24, 2003 Electronic Bulletin No. 382 RE: Winter Storm Alert

More sub-freezing temperatures are expected in the Midwest, Ohio Valley and Northeast tomorrow. In addition, snow is again expected for the Mid-Atlantic and the Northeast regions by Thursday, February 27th. The underlying railroads supporting these areas continue to operate trains, however, winter conditions are causing slower than normal transits. In many cases, the local and interstate highways are impassable, which will result in additional transit delays because the railroads use them to taxi crews to and from trains requiring another crew.

Similarly, terminal operations in these locations are being negatively affected by the ice, snow and cold temperatures.
