RE: Temporary change to Los Angeles cutoff

The UPRR is embarking upon a major railroad tie replacement program between Yermo, California and Las Vegas, Nevada from May 7 through May 24. This major project will force a temporary operating revision to some of our services operating from Los Angeles to Chicago and beyond to Northeastern destinations. Rather than delaying your freight as a result of this project we have reached agreement with the UPRR to operate our Chicago destined trains on an earlier schedule from Los Angeles. In addition, UPRR will start the project each day somewhat later than originally planned to permit passage of the Pacer Stacktrain business without delay on the somewhat earlier schedule.

Effective May 7 through May 24 only, **Los Angeles to Chicago** and beyond destined freight will have a Cutoff of 1800 in lieu of current 2100 at the UPRR East Los Angeles Terminal.

There will be no revision to the current 2100 cutoff for **City of Industry to Chicago** and beyond destined freight.
