





June 2, 2003 Electronic Bulletin No. 413 RE: Temporary Atlanta cutoff

Please be advised that the BNSF railroad will have an absolute maintenance of way curfew to replace over 30,000 concrete and wood railroad ties in Louisiana beginning June 9<sup>th</sup> for six weeks. The tie gang will be working between 0600 and 1400 Monday through Friday near Lafayette, LA. As a result, no trains will be allowed to operate through this area for eight hours. In order to bypass this curfew, our gate cutoff in Atlanta will be temporarily changed from 2100 to 1900 beginning Saturday, June 7<sup>th</sup> through July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2003.

There will be no delays to our Eastbound operating trains because they operate on a separate parallel track.

As a reminder, we will issue another communication when the gate cutoff returns to its original time.
