To our valued customers,

The Canadian National Railroad (CNRR) is attempting to clear out an excessive accumulation of loads at their Toronto ramp. Many Canadian customers are operating at 50% capacity, mainly due to the energy cutbacks that the government has imposed since the blackout ten days ago. To alleviate congestion, CNRR is limiting the number of trucks allowed in their terminal. This is necessary for safety reasons and to allow CNRR adequate space to maneuver. This policy will remain in effect until the backlog of loads is picked up by all customers.
