

December 17, 2003 Electronic Bulletin No. 453 RE: Peak Season Surcharge To End - Eastbound General Rate Increase To Be Implemented

Peak Season Surcharge End Date:

Pacer Stacktrain will end the eastbound peak season surcharge on all eastbound domestic shipments effective January 31, 2004.

General Rate Increase:

Effective February 1, 2004 Pacer Stacktrain will increase rates **FROM** ramps in the States of California, Oregon and Washington. The increase amount is shown below:

\$25 from Northern California (OAK, SAC, SCK), Oregon and Washington ramps to all destinations.

From Southern California (CDY, LAX, SAN) to the following destination ramps:

\$60 to the following destination ramps:

ATL, BAL, BOS, BUF, CHS, CHR, CLE, CMH, DTT, GRS, HAR, JAX, KEA, MIA, MON, PHL, PTT, PTS, STP, SAV, SPF, SYR, TOR and WOR

\$50 to the following destination ramps:

CHI, KCK, MEM, NWO and STL

\$25 to the following destination ramps:

DAL and HOU

Exceptions to this increase will be limited to quotes that Pacer Stacktrain has contractually agreed not to increase for a specific time frame.
