Re: CSX Service revisions to and from Philadelphia, Pa.

In an effort to improve overall network efficiency and terminal velocity, the CSX railroad cancelled and revised some of it's train services. One such train service, is the direct train service operating to and from Philadelphia, Pa. Effective Monday, June 28, 2004, it will be cancelled and replaced by a less direct alternative service that will route through Kearny, NJ and catch a train connection supporting Philadelphia, Pa.

## Westbound from Philadelphia, Pa:

New Gate cutoff is 1000 Daily

Old Gate cutoff was 1900 Daily

So, volume originating in Philadelphia, Pa will incur one extra day's transit to all respective Westbound destinations currently served.

## Eastbound to Philadelphia, Pa:

All current train service origins with a destination of Philadelphia, Pa will also incur one extra day's transit because of the revised routing through Kearny, NJ as mentioned above.

We apologize for the inconvenience that this service change may cause, but we feel strongly that the overall service benefits will overshadow the near term negative effect.
