

July 9, 2004 Electronic Bulletin No. 526 Re: Los Angeles Satellite Ramp at Montebello, Ca

Distribution:

In an effort accommodate the increased volumes during peak season, and to help alleviate the already heavily congested East Los Angeles intermodal ramp, effective Monday, July 12, 2004, the UPRR will dray off all westbound loads and revenue empties to a satellite ramp in Montebello, CA that originate from the following origins:

Armourdale (Kansas City) Council Bluffs (Omaha) Denver Dupo (St. Louis) Salt Lake City

Montebello, CA Intermodal Ramp: 329 Van Norman Road Montebello, Ca 90640

This ramp is within a 10 mile radius of the UPRR East Los Angeles facility. The UPRR will dray off the containers within 24 hours of discharge, and container notification will be made when these shipments are physically ingated at the Montebello, CA satellite ramp.

All Domestic and International container movement of all container sizes will be affected by this temporary change.

Pacer Stacktrain will not require any rail billing changes.
