

August 10, 2004 Electronic Bulletin No. 540 Re: United States Customs/Canadian Border Protection Requirements

To Our Valued Customers:

In conjunction with United States Customs and Border Protection, the Canadian National Rail Road (CN) will enforce the following billing requirements effective Wednesday, August 11, 2004 on shipments originating out of Canada. These billing requirements were previously communicated in our Stack Facts #522 dated 6/30/04. To ensure continued smooth transborder operations, shippers must provide full transborder shipment information to Pacer Stacktrain as listed below. This information must be submitted via EDI.

- 1. Equipment initial/number
- 2. Actual shipper name, address, city, province/state
- 3. Final consignee, address, city, province/state
- 4. Importer name, address, city, province/state
- 5. Customs Broker, address, city, province/state
- 6. Total number of pieces and package type (needs to be exact and >1)
- 7. Complete and accurate description of goods/STCC code
- 8. Total weight and unit of measure
- 9. Invoice value and currency (If the goods are being cleared at the border, this is not required. If moving in bond, the information must be provided)
- 10. Country of origin of the goods
- 11. Complete route
- 12. Seal numbers (If the goods are being cleared at the border, this is not required. If moving in bond, the information must be provided.

Please be aware that shipments lacking any of the above billing information will not be allowed in the gate.
