

August 13, 2004 Electronic Bulletin No. 541 Re: Pacer Stacktrain Service Update

Hurricane Charley is expected to make landfall late afternoon Aug.13th, 2004 near Tampa, Fl. and move along the Florida Panhandle towards the Northeast thru Jacksonville, Fl. Hurricane Charley is expected to bring heavy rain and damaging high winds to the already near flood stage levels left in the wake of Tropical Storm Bonnie yesterday.

All CSX Intermodal Terminals, except Tampa, Fl. are open and operational at this time. Jacksonville, Fl. gate will close tonight at midnight and will reopen after damage assessments have been made when storm has passed.

All customers are being encouraged to pick up their containers as soon as possible before Hurricane Charley makes landfall.

Some inbound trains to Jacksonville, FL. will be held online until hurricane has passed.
