Re: New Satellite Facility for International Volume Billed to San Antonio

To Our Valued Customer:

Due to heavy in-bound volume at UPRR's San Antonio TX ramp and the resultant congestion, the UPRR has established a satellite facility at Remount TX. Effective immediately, all international volume billed to San Antonio will be drayed to Remount by the UPRR, with notification of availability issued upon ingate at Remount. The Remount facility is fenced and secure and the UPRR will use a bonded cartage agent to move units from the San Antonio ramp to Remount.

Trains en route to San Antonio will continue to be metered so that the San Antonio TOFC ramp can remain fluid. The Remount facility should allow the San Antonio ramp to increase productivity, and hopefully negate the need for metering in the near term. The Remount facility is projected to remain in operation for thirty to forty days.

Directions:

- The satellite facility is approximately six miles from the Sherman Street ramp
- Heading North on Interstate 35 from New Braunfels Street, turn left (west) on Rittiman
- Go under Interstate 35 to second light
- At Rittiman Plaza turn left.
- Stay on Rittiman Plaza until you come to dead end.
- Turn left at dead end and continue until you reach the "Check-in" gate
