

## January 21, 2005 Electronic Bulletin No. 623 Re: Per Diem Relief Due To UPRR Embargo

Dear Valued Customer,

Pacer Stacktrain will be providing extended per diem relief due to the UPRR Embargo on service to and From the Los Angeles Basin.

Pacer Stacktrain will grant additional free days on units that were outgated on or prior to the embargo date of January 11, 2005 and could not be returned until after the embargo is lifted. The additional free days will include all days the unit was outgate during this time plus three additional days after the embargo is lifted. This relief will only apply to containers that were outgated empty and returned loaded (Empty/Load) or outgated loaded and re-loaded (Load/Load).

For example, if the embargo ends on January 24th and a unit was outgated empty on January 8th and returned loaded on January 31st, it will receive an additional 17 days of free time (January11th-January 27th).

Please note, any empty container pickups in these lanes will be allowed 3 additional free days allowing our customers the ability to begin providing capacity to their customers in preparation for the opening of the rail system.

The ramps that are eligible to receive this per diem relief are as follows:
