RE: Limited Intermodal Service Begins on Embargoed UP Routes

Dear Valued Customer,

Traffic on the Coast Line and Nevada's Caliente Line reopened January 24, 2005, on a limited basis for a short period as final work is completed. The Caliente Line will be operating at reduced capacity for approximately one week as Union Pacific monitors their service capabilities to support additional train services.

As a result of the restoration in service, UP has announced further plans to restore almost daily westbound intermodal service between Chicago and the LA Basin with significantly fewer volume restrictions than previously announced. Effective immediately, the following lanes are open to all traffic Westbound to East Los Angeles and ICTF.

Origin Point:

Council Bluffs/Omaha

Denver

Salt Lake City

CSX Intermodal has opened all Northeast terminal gates to intermodal volume moving to the LA Basin effective immediately. CSX will coordinate the westbound interchange of this traffic in Chicago with the UP to ensure operating efficiency and minimal delays.

**EASTBOUND:** UP will continue to operate eastbound trains from East LA to Chicago and beyond under the permit process implemented last week.

Pacer, in conjunction with UP and CSX will continue to monitor service capabilities. Additional intermodal services will be operated as conditions continue to improve.
