RE: Per Diem Relief Due To UPRR Embargo - Update

Dear Valued Customer,

The UPRR Embargo on **Intermodal** service to and from the Los Angeles Basin has **NOT** been lifted yet. UP is running limited service over the affected route and PACER STACKTRAIN continues to operate under an allocation system.

Pacer Stacktrain would like to affirm with our customers that we will provide per diem relief for delays caused by this embargo as outlined in Stack Facts #623 sent out on 1/21/05.

In particular we want to encourage our customers to **pick up empty equipment now** for loading to begin providing capacity to their customers to use under the allocation process and in preparation for the unrestricted opening of the rail system.

Empty equipment picked up now through the day the embargo ends will be granted additional free days.

The additional free days will consist of all days while the embargo remains in effect plus an additional 3 free days beyond normal free time.

The ramps that are eligible to receive this per diem relief are as follows:

East Los Angeles
Chicago – Global 1, Global 3
Global Gateway South
Kansas City
City of Industry
Dupo/St. Louis
ICTF – San Pedro
Omaha/Council Bluffs
On-dock facilities - Long Beach
Denver
Salt Lake City

CSX Northeast points – Kearny, Harrisburg, Baltimore, Portsmouth, Norfolk, Springfield, and Worcester

The above mention relief only applies to loads tendered to us for movement over the embargoed corridor.
