During the winter, our containers travel through some extremely cold conditions; much like over-the-road trucks, rail boxcars, and most other types of freight transportation modes.

The U.S. rail network has been significantly handicapped by several winter weather events, and winter is far from over. More severe weather and frigid temperatures are to be expected.

It is important to note that Pacer Stacktrain does not accept any liability for any temperature-related damages. Our containers are not equipped to protect cargo from freezing or other temperature-related damages.
