The Canadian National railroad (CNRR) and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) have signed a tentative labor contract covering the 644 union members who maintain and repair CN's signals and communications systems across Canada, thereby averting a potential labor disruption.

The CN had originally stated that if there was any labor disruption, service would not be affected. And due to these latest developments, the CN certainly does not expect any related service issues.
