Please refer to our March 8, 2005 Stack Facts (# 638) revising service between Salt Lake City and Chicago.

Eastbound service from Salt Lake City to Chicago Global One has not been executed according to design and plan. As a result, and in the effort to return Eastbound service to a higher degree of service reliability, the following revisions are effective immediately:

We understand the confusion a split Chicago terminal operation may cause, however the advantages of improved eastbound service reliability outweigh this temporary terminal inconvenience. We expect this to last for the next 45 to 60 days.
