Re: U.S. Custom Requirements - Canadian Shipments - Effective May 2. 2005

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective May 2, 2005 for shipments originating Canada and destined for the United States, the CN railroad will accept only electronic submissions of data required by the U.S. Trade Act. CN will no longer require or accept faxing of this information. (Please refer to Bulletin #10 on the CN website.)

The required information includes cargo value, full shipper, consignee, importer, broker, and IT information where applicable. Please see the Pacer Stack Directory, Section 9.3.2 and 9.3.4 for complete information on all of the requirements.

Pacer Stacktrain is fully capable of receiving all of the required information in your EDI 404 billing and has instituted edit checks to ensure these requirements are fully met. Accordingly, incomplete billing will be suspended pending receipt of the required information. This may result in unnecessary delays for drivers delivering to origin ramps.

To facilitate timely processing of your billing please ensure that your EDI 404 contains all of the required information.
