Re: Gate Reservation Change and New Lane Announcement

Dear Valued Customer:

This announcement is to advise you of new lanes requiring Gate Reservations, as well as procedure changes in existing lanes.

The Union Pacific has recently announced the next lanes to be covered in the continued expansion of their Gate Reservation System. Beginning on **July 5th**, **2005**, the following Pacer Stacktrain lanes will be added to system:

## Salt Lake City to:

- Long Beach ICTF
- Oakland
- Portland (Albina)
- Seattle

These lanes to the West Coast are in addition to those lanes already in effect (\*\*) from the Salt Lake City ramp. All Domestic and International shipments will require a reservation in order to be allowed in the gate at the UPRR ramp.

Effective Monday June 27th, customers requesting in-gate reservations for East Los Angeles, Salt Lake City and Stockton/Sacramento must now specify one of the following as the destination point:

- Chicago Local (Global 1)
- Chicago Interchange to CSX (All Northeast, Ohio Valley, & Eastern Canada destinations\*\*)

**This is a change from previous instructions.** Customers must now separate requests for Chicago Local (Global 1) traffic from requests for Chicago traffic bound for CSX Interchange destinations.
