PacerMex Gateway Service to end:

Effective January 1, 2006, Pacer Stacktrain announces the cancellation of the PacerMex Gateway service which currently provides doublestack service between Laredo, Texas and Cuautitlan, Mexico.

As of January 1st 2006, the fleet that Pacer Stacktrain had dedicated to the Gateway service will be reincorporated into our other services. This restructuring of the Gateway service was required in order to improve the overall service and operational efficiency of our PacerMex services.

PacerMex OneStop, NonStop and PacerMex Door Services will continue:

For shipments that originate in the interior United States destined for Mexico, Pacer Stacktrain will continue to offer the services that make your Mexico connections safe, smooth and secure:

- <u>PacerMex OneStop</u> Ship to Laredo via Pacer Stacktrain, keep border inspections in the hands of your preferred customs broker, then continue via Pacer Stacktrain to inland Mexico
- <u>PacerMex NonStop</u> Ship from the United States via Pacer Stacktrain direct to your final Mexico destination bypassing border congestion with preapproved customs clearance
- <u>PacerMex Door</u> Ship to Laredo via Pacer Stacktrain and take advantage of Pacer's integrated, single-bill door delivery service to select Mexico cities
