Dear Valued Customer:

In observance of the Labor Day Holiday, we will be closed for normal operations on Monday, September 4th. Normal operations will return on Tuesday, September 5th.

Pacer Stacktrain services with a scheduled cut-off on Monday, September 4th will not operate. Volume tendered to the Pacer Stacktrain network prior to September 4th will continue to operate through to destination with approximately an 8-12 hour delay. Those services with scheduled arrival and availability on September 4th will be delayed 24 hours at the arrival terminal due to the Holiday operating schedule and the build-up of containers inside the rail terminals.

Customer Support and Equipment Reservations will be closed on Monday, September 4th. Customer Support and Equipment Reservations can be accessed via our website. Please remember you will be able to track loads by using our new Interactive Voice Response (IVR) system by dialing: 800-876-7281 - Eastern Region, 800-933-7822 - Western Region.

We will have Customer Support in our Laredo office to monitor northbound and southbound Mexico crossborder traffic during the Holiday weekend. Coverage will be 9:30am to 1:30pm CST on Saturday September 2nd, 10:00am to 2:00pm CST on Sunday, September 3rd and from 8:00am to 5:00pm CST on Monday, September 4th. Gate Reservations for domestic traffic for September 4th and 5th must be made prior 9:30am PDT on Friday, September 1st. Gate Reservations for international traffic using ICTF must be made prior to 10:00am PDT on Friday, September 1st.
