Re: ALERT - Severe Storm Delays Rail Service in Midwest

Dear Valued Customer:

A wintery mix of rain, sleet and snow is currently passing through the Midwest and Great Lakes Region. Chicago, Detroit, Kansas City and St. Louis intermodal terminals, as well as over the road operations are significantly affected, and have resulted in some shortages of railcar and locomotive assets because operations are moving at reduced speeds. Some interstate highways have been closed. A wind chill alert has been issued in Tennessee, Ohio, Virginia, Pennsylvania, New York, and other parts along the Eastern Seaboard and into the Northeast.
