RE: Updated Restrictions on 53' Containers - Omaha, NE and Miami, FL now Open

To our valued customers and draymen,

We are pleased to announce that Omaha, NE and Miami, FL destination ramps no longer have 53' container restrictions. As a result, destination guidelines, last outlined in Stack Facts No. 688, dated August 11, 2005, have been updated, below.

In order to maximize the availability of our 53' containers, we must ask for your assistance in managing their movement throughout our system. Please note the following load destination guidelines:

Pacer Stacktrain 53' containers must NOT be loaded to the following destination ramps noted with an "X":

	<u>53'-110"</u>	<u>53'-107"</u>
• Charleston, SC	X	X
• Montreal, QC, Canada	X	OK
• New Orleans, LA	X	X
• Queretaro, QR, Mexico	X	OK
• Savannah, GA	X	X
• St. Paul, MN	X	X
• Toronto, ON, Canada	X	OK

Pacer Stacktrain high-cube 53'-110" containers cannot load to any of the locations listed above. Our high-cube 53'-110" containers are easily identified by their red corner posts and numbers starting with 88 (PACU 88xxxx) or higher.

Our standard 53'-107" containers cannot be loaded to the ramps noted above with the exception that our smaller 107" high containers can be loaded to the Canada and Mexico locations.
