RE: Announcing Southbound Service Discontinued Between Dupo, IL and Laredo,

TX, Effective March 5, 2007

Dear Valued Customer:

Effective Monday March 5, 2007, Union Pacific Railroad will discontinue Southbound service between Dupo, IL and Laredo, TX. The last day to tender freight for this Southbound service will be Saturday March 3, subject to published cut-off times.

Interline traffic moving to/from Mexico will also be affected by this service cancellation.

This action is being taken by the UPRR to strengthen network fluidity and create additional capacity in the long-haul North/South corridor.
