Planned Service Outage on Holiday

To Our Valued Customers:

Please be advised that the Union Pacific Railroad will be accomplishing a major track crossing removal and replacement where the Union Pacific and Burlington Northern Santa Fe cross at Rochelle, Illinois on Monday, September 4, 2000.

Union Pacific has chosen the holiday to accomplish this work in an attempt to disrupt the least amount of rail traffic possible while the railroad is completely shut down for 12 hours. Burlington Northern Santa Fe will be shut down during the same time-frame.

This much needed work will produce long term benefits for the route between the West Coast, Midwest and Northeast, but will delay services on September 4. Since this is a holiday, we are hopeful this service interruption will have minimal impact upon ability to pick-up volume on September 5 in Chicago.
